Delivering public culture through the trust model

"A Trust will align itself with the cultural strategy of the local authority putting purpose before profit. The Trust will actively seek ways to engage with stakeholders and the community. Profit is a byproduct of this collaboration and not the reason for it."

The foundation of the trust model

- Innovative, quality programmes and services
- Ability to diversify income streams and access specific pots of funding
- Agile decision-making in response to community needs.
- Charitable purpose

- Bookbug; national early years book gifting programme
- Co-creation and adapted delivery
- Partnership working increased accessibility of Bookbug locally

Aura Leisure & Libraries *Flintshire, Wales*

- Five Ways of Wellbeing in a museum setting
- Co-creation: leaflet designed by local residents
- Mental health and children; emphasis on play and having fun





Active Luton Luton, England

- Libraries integrated into a leisure trust
- Library service integrated into to health and wellbeing team
 - Social prescribing providing support and vital connections with professional services
